You may be nominated for a position yourself, so it is important you turn up to accept (or decline) any offers.

The other important thing to note is the Calendar also included in this issue. Please note - it is only a *draft* and may be changed at any time, depending on circumstances. We have done our best to provide some sort of event on each free weekend of the year, including events in neighbouring Cairns & Whitsunday Clubs. More events may be planned, or items may be cancelled. If you have agreed to Direct an event & later find you cannot commit yourself for whatever reason (it had better be a damned good one!) then you *MUST* let someone know, either the President or Secretary or Club Captain. As is often pointed out, we need a genuine team effort to get this Club running to full potential, so do your part. A couple of them have entered some neighbouring events, such as Cardwell '95 & Dray Park Autocross, and they have also got underway with a range of events of their own. Another draft calendar, this time from C.A.M.S. Qld. is included, with details of proposed Cairns Club events. The most notable is the 5 round Khanacross Series, Supp. Regs. also included. It might be worthwhile for a few members to check out a few rounds - as mentioned before, if we show interest in other Club's events, they will generally return the favour, and remember: more entrants at events means more money coming in, which means more events - for you.

Several people have expressed concern that important issues are not being communicated thoroughly to all members. As a general rule, that is my job, as Editor. Stories of how whenever we had an event, *everybody* let *everybody else* know about it. One method of achieving this was that each member had about 3 people to ring. If they found out about an event coming up, they would inform their 3 people regardless, with the resultant pyramid effect ensuring that nobody missed an event "because nobody told me it was on." It is up to *all of us* to make sure we *all* get out there and have some fun.

KHANA CROSS SERIES

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATION

ADMINISTRATION

The event shall be known as The (Sponsor) FNQ Motor Sports Club Khana Cross Series. The event hereafter known as the "Event" held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., The National Competition Rules of Cams, and further rules and regulations under the Khana Cross code.

The Event will be conducted under Cams Permit No. (To Be Advised) and will be open to invited clubs only. This being FNQ Motor Sports Club, Twin Cities Autosports Club, Whitsunday Sporting Car Club, Mackay Off Road & Rally Club and Central QLD Motorsporting Club.

The Event will be conducted in Cairns at venues To Be Advised.

The Event will be conducted over 5 rounds with points issued for each round to determine the series winners. The best of 3 of 5 rounds will be counted. Round 3 will be part of Suncorp North Queensland Games and Double Points will be issued for this round along with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals for Outright, Class and Junior winners.

Director of the Event shall be Jim Cavill (070) 514382.

Secretary of the Event shall be Jim Cavill (070) 514382.

Steward for the Event shall be Tom Porrit and (TBA).

Organising Committee Jim Cavill, Mitch Lewis, Rod Harris and Graham King.

Crew shall be driver only except for Novice driver who shall be permitted to take a "navigator" for tuition purposes only (navigator being a most experienced competitor).

Driver and or entrant must be a financial member of a Cams Affiliated club being the FNQ Motor Sports Club or invited club.

The Driver must have current Cams basic licence for 1996.

Juniors under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardians permission to compete and have the endorsement signed on the entry.

Entries open on the 5th January 1996 and close for the series at 5pm on 16th February 1996. Fee for all 5 rounds shall be \$60-00 non refundable after the closing date. Entry to any single round shall open 6 weeks before the date of the round and will close on Friday at 5pm the week before the date of each round. Fee for any single round shall be \$20-00 non refundable after the closing date.

All rounds will be limited to the first 25 drivers entered.

The Competition

Each round of the series shall be run under the Khana Cross Code. Results will be determined. Loss of points winners being those who have lost the least number of points. Each competitor shall receive points in order of finishing from 35 down to 1 awarded to each.

Penalties as per the Khana Cross code.

All rounds shall start at 12 noon. Scrutineering shall start 10:30am at the venue (TBA) of all rounds.

Scrutineering Requirements

Helmets shall be worn during competition meeting as 1698 or International equivalent. Clothing for the day of each round of the Event for drivers and pit crew shall be non Flammable material, covering from ankles to neck and wrists (ie. long sleeve shirts, long pants or overalls). Driver is encouraged to wear driving suits.

Covered footwear of non-flammable material shall be worn at all times by the crew and drivers during the Event. No thongs, Roman Sandals or High Heel shoes to be worn in or around the pit paddock area.

Fire extinguisher of AS 1841, 1846, 1848 of at least 900 gram should be fitted in the vehicle in a suitable and accessible location during competition.

Clothing, footwear, helmets and licence will be checked and enforced rigidly. Failure to comply may mean exclusion from the Event.

All protests shall be in accordance with NCR part XII of Cams Manual of Motor Sport and accompanied by the appropriate fee.


