More on Supp Regs

If people read their Supp Regs prior to the event or even bothered to look up the NCRs in the CAMS manual they would understand what they are required to do. Instead of turning up to events and not understanding why the scrutineer or the event director is upset with them. For example NCR 69 states that the entry form must be completed in full this means 'AS ABOVE' is not the Driver of the vehicle or in some cases the Co - Driver.

NCR 80 requires all entries to close 7days prior to the event. This is so as the event director can advise CAMS who the competitors are and service crews so as insurance coverage can be organised as well all competitors must receive a receipt of entry stating their entry is accepted along with the starting order.

How can the event director do this if people don't put their entries in on time or turn up at scrutineering with their entry form.




