

#### **EDITORS SAY**

It has come to my attention that some people have been obtaining the wrong type of third party extensions from their insurance companies through no fault of there own, meaning there vehicles are not covered for competitive events as required by the event Supp Regs. Apparently the insurance companies (through inexperience or whatever) are providing insurance coverage for the transport of

unregistered vehicles from A to B, also at a higher cost than the required extension.

Following investigations through Suncorp Metway one of a number of CTP Insurance Companies (check your rego papers for your CTP insurer), when you apply for you Third Party Extension you need to specify exactly what it is for and make sure it covers you for Motorsport. The following is from a local Suncorp Metway agent, Mr. Les Prosser, Shop 7/322 Fulham Rd Heatley (4725 0600).

#### Dear Ron.

The required documentation for a rally/sprint/mountain climb etcetera is called a CTP RALLY EXTENSION.

The CTP RALLY EXTENSION is purely a received in the content of the

The CTP RALLY EXTENSION is purely a receipt issued by the CTP Insurer of the registered vehicle stating that an extension has been granted for motor racing. A surcharge of \$10.00 per day of event applies, this being payable to the insurer.

- A CTP CERTIFICATE itself is issued in either of the following two circumstances:
- 1) Covering a 6 or 12 month period when registering a motor vehicle; or
- 2) When shifting an unregistered motor vehicle from "Point A to Point B" (eg: from home to a mechanic).

Please note the CTP RALLY EXTENSION is to be obtained from the vehicles CTP Insurer as stated on their registration papers.

If you have any queries, please don't hesitate to call.

So next time make sure you have the right insurance coverage.

And now for the bad news. 
This amendment was approved by the Australian Rally Commission via facsimile vote.

#### **BITUMEN SPRINT**

The first official bitumen sprint meeting held in Queensland outside the SouthEast corner was held on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May by the Marque Sports Car Register of North Queensland at the Townsville Kart

Track. A good cross section of vehicles competed in six different classes for a day of fun motorsport.

There were twenty-seven starters for the day split into six classes based on engine capacity. Some of the more interesting entries were Robert Johnson from the Burdekin in his Mini Cooper S and local Leon Addison in a Ford Cortina GT 500 in the small car class. Eric Gustavson in a Datsun Roadster in class two, Tony Blackshaw from Mackay in a Mazda RX7 Turbo and Les Gidney in the 1969 Dodge Dart 440 in the bigger engine class.

Asser Saaristo in his 1937 Singer Sports won his class with an excellent display of precision driving in the historic racecar. At the other end of the motoring spectrum was Geoff Pickering winning two classes with his Honda S2000 Sport and the latest in Rally technology, a Mitsubishi Lancer EVO6 4WD. Other class winners for the day were Ian Ogilvie in a Datsun 1200 Coupe, Michael Seymour Datsun 260Z and Warren Skimmings Datsun 260Z Turbo.

The battle for outright placings went on for the entire day. Michael Seymour put in some blistering early lap times but fell foul of a mechanical problem, which sidelined him for the last three runs. His secure second fastest time of the day stood until Geoff Pickering's very last lap of the competition to jump to second outright by one-hundredth of a second – he recorded a 44.77 second lap to Michael's 44.78 seconds. Warren Skimmings had been getting quicker most of the day to finish with a time of 43.57 seconds to record a maximum points win.

This event was round two of the Top Gear Bitumen Sprint Series teamed with the Mt. Stuart Hillclimb, which will become a six (?) event series. The next Sprint round is scheduled for July with a Hillclimb planned for August.

# MOTOR SPORT COMMUNITY MOURNS THE PASSING OF LEADING FIGURE

The Hon. John Dawson-Damer died at the weekend while competing in an historic event. His passing will affect a great many people, as he was one of the most liked and respected personalities in the motor sport world.

His common sense and generous spirit immensely aided the progress of the many committees and other activities he so completely threw himself into. His influence was worldwide and lasting through his role as a member of the FIA Historic Cars Commission.

In Australia, his unstinting service to the development of the historic movement will be strongly missed. As Peter Hansen, CEO of CAMS, the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport put it, with the passing of the Hon. John Dawson-Damer, CAMS has lost not only a friend and loyal supporter, but also a capable Chairman of its Historic Commission with whom I enjoyed a close working relationship based on friendship and mutual respect. We

all owe it to JDD, as he was known, to work hard for the ongoing development of historic motor sport in Australia and around the world.

JDD enjoyed motor sport in many different forms over his lifetime and was well known for his achievement as Australian Rally Championship Navigator in 1978 with Greg Carr and the Ford Team. He also rallied with Colin Bond in the 1970s and, in recent years, they competed together in Targa Tasmania.

However, he was best known for owning probably the best Formula One Lotus private collection anywhere and for racing his cars with vigour wherever there was an opportunity. It was in driving the very rare and difficult 1969 Type 63 four wheel drive Gold Leaf FI car at the Goodwood Festival of Speed Hillclimb in England that JDD had his tragic accident. Sadly, two marshals were involved, one being killed and the other seriously injured.

The Board and Management of CAMS passes on its heartfelt condolences to Mrs. Ashley Dawson-Darner and family and his many friends around the world. JDD will be sorely missed.


