Date of Implementation: 1 January 2001

TECHNICAL BULLETIN PRODUCTION RALLY CARS

REFERENCE:

2000 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Section 11 - Road Events, Schedule R – Requirements For All Rally Cars, Article 10 (page 11-49).

RATIONALE:

To upgrade the requirements for fire extinguishing systems in rally cars.

AUTHORITY:

This change was approved by the Australian Rally Commission at its meeting of 9th – 10th October 1999 at Minute 2.2.19.

ACTION:

Add as the second last dot point of Article 10 the following:

"PRC Rally Cars and Group N Rally Cars are to be equipped with a plumbed-in fire extinguisher system homologated by the FIA for use in competition cars which was in force on or after the date of issue of the vehicle log book, in accordance with the following time table;

for ARC events (except for drivers competing in their home states) – 1st January 2001, and

for State Championship events or higher, other than ARC, (except cars manufactured prior to 1st January 2000*) – 1st January 2003.

(*Note: This date refers to the original date of manufacture of the vehicle, and not the date on which it was built as a rally car)."

ELDORADO HELMETS

The long running saga of the Eldorado Helmets has had its final sequel with the delivery of a ruling in the court case. MHG Plastics, Australia's only manufacturer of vehicle users helmets has had a victory in its fight to restore its Eldorado brand helmets for use in Australia. The Eldorado "EXR",

"RXR" and "MXR" were withdrawn from the market after post manufacturing tests showed an apparent failure of the helmets ability to conform to AS1698. The court ruled that the tests were improperly applied, and members with the affected helmets may now use them again for all CAMS events, save for International events.
