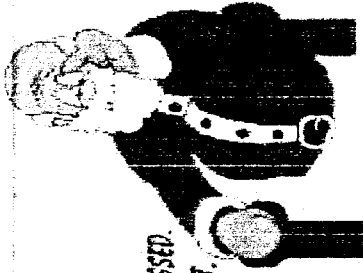
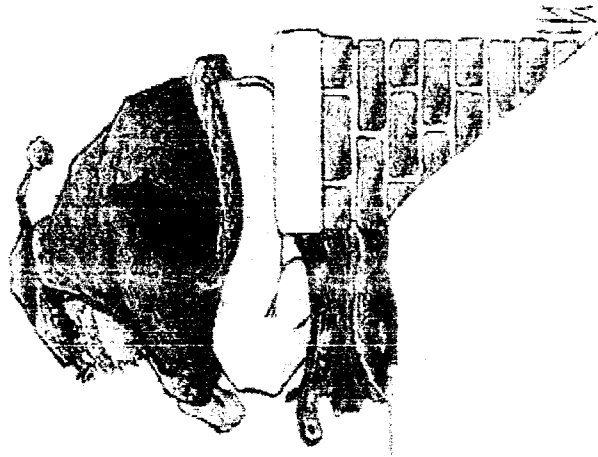

FLYING THROUGH THE AIR- DODGING THE TREES

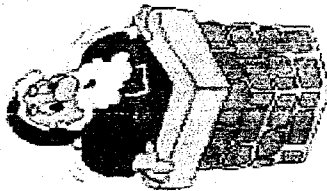
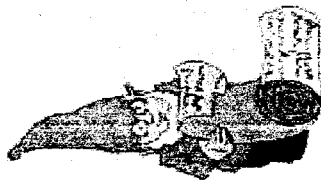
FALLING DOWN CHIMNEYS AND SKINNING MY KNEES

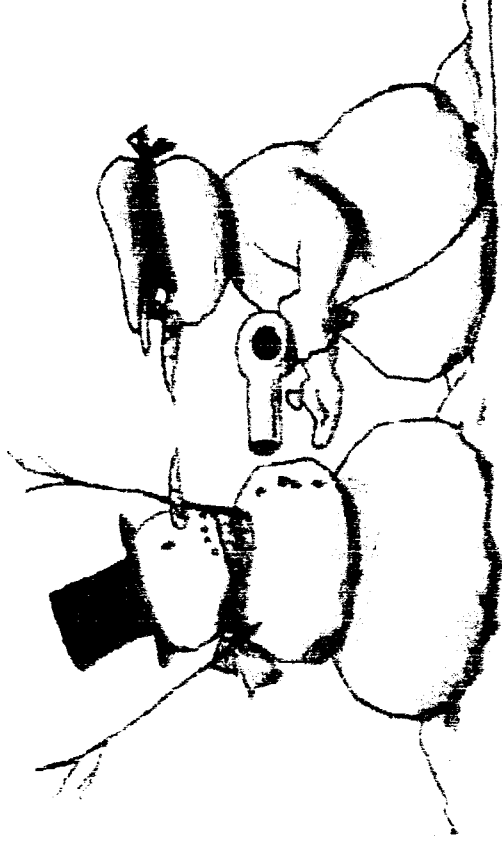
