

CAMS' PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE SECURED FOR 2004/2005 WITH GOOD NEWS FOR CAMS MEMBERS AND STAKEHOLDERS

CAMS has secured renewal of it's \$100 million Public Liability Insurance Policy for 2004/2005.

CAMS' policy has been secured for the period July 2004 to June 2005 with the same level of cover. CAMS was offered a significantly enhanced range of options this year and, after consideration of these options, has chosen a programme with excess of \$10,000 per incident as compared to the expiring policy which had an excess of \$100,000 per incident.

Further good news for CAMS members, circuit owners promoters and other stakeholders, is that the organization's strong financial position has allowed the improved insurance programme to be accommodated without the need to increase fees to CAMS members.

"CAMS has been able to secure public liability insurance with key underwriters of the 2003/2004 policy, building on relationships that were established 12 months ago" said CAMS Chief Executive Officer Dr Rob Nethercote.

"The reduction of the excess from \$100,000 per incident to \$10,000 per incident provides CAMS and the sport overall with greater surety. As has been the case previously, the insurance policy specifically requires CAMS to cover any excess payable on an incident."

Nethercote concluded "The success of this insurance renewal illustrates the insurance industry's recognition of CAMS' strong risk management procedures, which are continually evolving to ensure that they are in line with the world's best practice."

QUICK PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Well, things are starting to happen. The Townsville City Council has resurfaced the Mt Stuart Hillclimb road course at a cost of \$52000. The new hotmix surface has provided a course equal to any in the country. The Council have also committed to funding a kilometre per year for the next two financial years to match the proposed extension of the course to 3 kilometres. In exchange for the resurfacing the Council has asked for a development plan for the Mt Stuart course, which has been provided. The plan includes levelling of the spectator area, some improvements, levelling and sealing of the pit/parking area as a motorkhana pad. We have written support of the Police Academy in our plan for the motorkhana pad, as they, like every other Government agency, have to travel to Brisbane to conduct driver training and would be interested in using the facility. The plan for the last hillclimb (22nd August) is to promote the event as the official opening of the new course.

More good news, we have been granted \$3000 to develop a business plan so that we can identify a clear direction for the future of the club.

I have also applied for a Volunteer Small Equipment Grant to purchase a portable shade structure (6x3m collapsible "quickshade") for our volunteer officials, so we don't have to borrow someone else's.

At the time of printing there is still no news on the application for the clubhouse in South Townsville, but keep your fingers crossed. Ron White


