

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FOR CLUBHOUSE.

Dear Sir,

The Twin Cities Autosports Club is a net-for-profit organisation incorporated in 1990 and is an affiliated member, with voting rights, of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS). Despite our recent unsuccessful Expression of Interest submission in the lease of building in Victoria Park, South Townsville (Old Croquet Club), the Twin Cities Autosports Club is still endeavouring to obtain a clubhouse to advance the development of our club.

The Twin Cities Autosports Club is currently going through a resurgence and renewed focus on the clubs activities and development plans for the future. One of the key components of our clubs' development strategy is the acquisition of a clubhouse. This will not only provide our club with a facility to centralise our assets and club operational documentation etc., currently scattered amongst committee members, but also provide a focal point for our members. A clubhouse will also provide a valuable venue to hold our monthly meetings, carry out regular training sessions for volunteer officials and members (inductions and updating of skills) and storage for club equipment, trophies and memorabilia, etc.

Presently, we have various venues where we conduct our events however, we do not have a clubhouse or any permanent 'tangible' address for our club that we can call our own. This has the effect of presenting the image of 'gipsies', not very desirable when trying to promote a stable and proactive club while seeking sponsorship and support. With the acquisition of a clubhouse, our members will gain a renewed focus and drive to develop and progress Twin Cities Autosports Club into the future.

To that end, we are requesting the Council consider our continuing need for a facility that could be utilised for club gatherings and meetings. We are also in need of modest storage facilities for our increasing asset holdings which include display trailer, course equipment such as rolls of bunting, signs, wooded stakes and high value items such as radios, tents, extinguishers, etc.



It would be appreciated if the Council could keep in mind our plight when buildings facilities become available from time to time.

Should such a potential facility by identified by the Council, it would be appreciated if Twin Cities Autosports Club could be contacted with the details to ascertain it's suitability.

The Twin Cities Autosports Club would greatly appreciate the opportunity to acquire a clubhouse to advance the development of our club, and so encourage discussions and negotiations on any opportunity that may arise.

Unfortunately by now you would know that the Cardwell Rally has been cancelled due to not being allowed into the forest because of the fire risk. However, Heckler is planning to run the Rallysprint at Charters Towers instead, so there should still be one more big event before the end of the year. Apart from the Ironman weekend that is.

Update on what's happening.

- I have sent a letter to both the Townsville and Thuringowa City Councils requesting consideration for a clubhouse if one becomes available.
- Procurement of shade in progressing.
- If anyone has some spare time and ideas to help with our Development Plan, please let me know.
- I met with the Townsville City Council recently to discuss the future development of the Mt. Stuart Hillclimb venue. The Council will be resurfacing more of the road course this year from their 'Roads' funding. They have also committed to help with the levelling and sealing of the parking and pit area for motorkhanas. Initially the area will be sealed with a spray seal and then at a later date resurfaced with asphalt. To protect the area from vandalism, the Council will assist with the construction of concrete barriers (motorsport type) to surround the area and potentially line the start of the Hillclimb course. (See me about info on the V8's coming to town). I am also dealing with the Council on issues like sponsor advertising and signage at the venue.
- I am endeavouring to clarify with State Office the process to follow in expending the \$1200 for safety equipment from previous QRC registration. I am looking at such things as vests, more radios, signage, etc.
- No response from SEA FM as yet. Will chase up.
