

Chris has done the minutes and secretary report this month, which can be found later in the newsletter.



#### Treasures Report: As tabled.

<u>Club Captain</u>: Good to see support for the BP Cluden motorkhana. All club members to be aware of the club image. Need to be a member to be part of the club championship scoring system. Existing club members should look at being mentors for new members like a buddy system.

<u>Editor</u>: Monthly newsletter will be sent out this week, still looking for more articles for the magazine. Discussion held in relation to if you win an event you need to put an article in the newsletter about the event.

<u>Presidents:</u> Thank you to Murray and Nikki for organising the Motorkhana last Sunday and Wendy and Stumpy for the timing. Good to see a healthy field of entries. We now have approval from BP Cluden to run regular events at the roadhouse and are happy with the way things are run. So when is the next one.

I am in the process of organising with the Police and Emergency Services verses Club day at some time in the future, possibly this year. It will be a Motorkhana at the BP Cluden Roadhouse and can include anyone interested. More details to follow.

Following a letter sent to the Dalrymple Shire Council requesting use of the Mingela Rodeo grounds, I received a call from the CEO of DSC last week advising that at present we cannot use the Mingela Rodeo Grounds (or other sites in the area) as they are gazetted Camping Reserves and do not allow our activities. The DSC have sent a letter to Dept of Natural

Resources, Mines and Water (DNRMW) requesting secondary use approvals so that we can conduct our activities. The off road club had approval to run one event only at the site but have continued to run events there ignoring the condition on approval. They have now been informed that no more events will be allowed until/ if approval from DNRMW is gained. Stay tuned. I have submitted a grant application for two 3m x 3m quick shades.

I have sent a proposal to ARCom requesting approval to run the Mt Stuart Sprint next year and have nominated the May day long weekend (if there is one next year). I have spoken to Errol Baley and he has agreed to assist with the event (the regulation's require a CI Event Director). The ARCom meeting should have been held 4-5 Aug, so it shouldn't be too long before I know what the decision is. Once we have approval to go ahead, I will need to pass on the organization of the Hillclimbs so that I can devote time to the planning and organization of the rally. Please consider if you would like to help with the event.

<u>Social director:</u> Working B on Saturday the 19<sup>th</sup> Aug at Mt Stuart Hillclimb track to clean up and prepare for the next Hillclimb Anyone willing to help with the Hillclimb please see Nathan Mullins or Chris Beckett.

### . General Business:

- Recently CAMS has introduced a policy on OH&S and Risk Management. Part of the Risk Management Safety System is the introduction of a Compliance Checker to all Motorsports events. Presented at the meeting was an explanation of the requirements and is to be phased in for our events by the I April 2007. It will become another onerous task for event directors, but it's coming so, it may be worth getting use to filling it out before April next year.
- 10% of entry fee's to be set aside for the purchase of land for the club. Murray asks for the clubs opinion on the use of sand at the Motorkhana held at BP Cluden and a discussion was held. (Murray)
- The issue of passenger's assisting drivers in Motorkhana was discussed, as there seems to be uncertainty if this should be allowed, Discussion held. (Deb)
- Still no word back from the Woodstock motorcycle club in relation to holding events there, but will follow up. Have followed up the Black River Rodeo Grounds and should be a going the only issue is the creek crossing. Discussion held> (Greg Wright)
- More social events need to be organized to keep members interested and to fill in the caps between events. (Wendy)
- There will be a training weekend in Brisbane possibly late November for the people interested in being a Compliance Checker, Heckler needs three names to put down, names put forward were Murray, Nikki & Travis and Greg Wright. (Heckler)
- New Venue: Chris and Gail Beckett. Sent a letter expression our interest in running an event at the Ayr showgrounds, the first event would be a 2-day Motorkhana and would utilise the local Loins and Rotary clubs for Catering. The proposed dates for this event should we get approval will be the 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> of October 2006. I am also planning a 2 day Touring Road Event for the 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> of February 2007. Should this event be a success I am planning to run 4 of the Touring Road Events in 2007. Discussion held.

# RYDGES CAPRICORN RALLY 29TH JULY 2006

And we were there!!! What's more we will be back again next year!
