### 06.020 Ref. RAP05.238 - Safety Boards for Rally Cars

Further discussions re the different sets of boards being carried in cars. The fluoro coloured boards will be issued free of charge by Scrutineers. Fluoro boards are seen better in some lighting situations.

### **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

### 06.028 Draft Qld Transport Regulations on Blue Plates for Rally Cars

Matt Van Tuinen brought forward issues on forthcoming Regulations to be legislated nationally. Items such as: Roll cages, seatbelts, harnesses, fuel tanks, emissions, rally registration.

FIA approval issues will be influential in Draft Regulations.


