




An Article From CAMS

Dear CAMS Member

The new licensing structure for the National Officiating Program is set to go live on 16 April and over the coming weeks and months you will begin to notice a number of major changes at the events you attend.

The following highlights the key changes from the previous system to the new system:

- 1. Officials who held a Grade 4 licence under the previous system will now be graded with a 'General Official' licence. General Officials will carry a blue passbook with them at events. These officials are still required to work under indirect supervision.
- 2. Officials who held a Grade 3 licence under the previous system will now be graded with a 'Bronze' licence. Bronze Officials will carry a bronze passbook with them at events and are qualified to officiate without supervision.
- 3. Officials who held a Grade 2 licence under the previous system will now be graded with a 'Silver' licence. Silver Officials will carry a silver passbook with them at events.
- 4. Officials who held a Grade 1 licence under the previous system will now be graded with a 'Gold' licence. Gold Officials will carry a Gold passbook with them at events.
- 5. In the instance where an official holds a number of licences at different grades, they will be issued with a passbook corresponding with the highest grade of licence held.
- 6. All the lettering classifications which were previously used to distinguish between different categories have now been removed and replaced with the actual category name. This will make it easier to recognise each official's qualifications.
- 7. Discipline specific licences have now been introduced for Rally, Off-Road and Circuit competition. A number of previous categories have been amalgamated into these licences: for further specific information go to: www.cams.com.au/go/officialscategories
- 8. Sub categories have been introduced for Gold and Silver discipline specific licences to indicate a speciality at that level; for further specific information go to: www.cams.com.au/go/officialscategories
- 9. A Club Chief licence has been created and will allow officials with motor sport experience to perform the role of:
 - * Clerk of the Course / Event Director at Club/Multi -Club events (excluding race, rally & off road events);
 - Club steward at Club/Multi-Club events (excluding race, rally & off road events); or
 - * Any other team leadership role (except Chief Scrutineer) at Club/ Multi-Club events (excluding race, rally & off road events).


