Supplementary Regulations for Round 1 TCAC Khanacross Series Talbot Park Khanacross Sunday 16th February 2014

1. The Event

The event shall be known as and Round 1 TCAC Khanacross Series of the Townsville City Autosports Club Khanacross series and be a Club Event to be held at Talbot Park on Sunday the 16th February.

Event time is Sunday start 09:00hrs and finish 15:00hrs or at the Clerk of Course discretion.

2. Authority

The event is authorised by CAMS permit No TBA, and shall be conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS, the Khanacross Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations, addenda and instructions as may be issued subject to NCR 69 and NCR 89 of the current CAMS Manual. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au. Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

3. Promoters

The promoters of the event shall be the Townsville City Autosports Club Inc.

4. Officials

5. Entries

Entries open 26th January 2014 Entries will close immediately prior to the competition beginning on Sunday 16th February 2014. Scrutiny will start at 08:00 hours Sunday.

Entry is \$35.00 and \$15.00 for Juniors. All money can be paid on the day of the event.

The maximum number of entries will be 40 and will be accepted in order of receipt. Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

Personal Accident Insurance is included in the entry fee.

All entries must be on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.

All cheques, etc. are to be made payable to Townsville City Autosports Club Inc.

6. Licences

All competitors must be a member of a CAMS affiliated club and be in possession of a CAMS L2NS/L2NSJ or superior licence. Such licence must be presented to the secretary of the event. All partnerships and registered companies must hold a CAMS Competitors Licence.

7. Draw

Starting order for all Competitors will be determined by ballot to be held at the event on 16th February 2014 Competitors may be rotated in running order to avoid one person starting each test.

8. Abandonment

The organisers reserve the right to alter, postpone, abandon or cancel the event, subject to the provisions of NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

9. Venue

The event shall be conducted at Talbot Park on Sunday 1st December 2013. The type of surface shall be various dirt surfaces. During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day.

Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will apply.

10. Timetable

Extension of scrutineering times will be at the discretion of the Clerk of Course or Chief Scrutineer.

11. Scrutiny

All vehicles shall comply with Schedule A and Group 4H Motorkhana of the current CAMS Manual.

Particular heed will be taken to battery security, safety condition of suspension, roll bars, safety harness and tyres as per NCR s. Approved crash helmets and eye protection (not sunglasses) are required for all non-production or open vehicles. Apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual.

Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. All vehicles must be fitted with an effective exhaust silencer system at all times. The maximum noise emission permissible is 95db(A).

All competitors must present the following documents at Scrutiny: A current competition licence, current CAMS affiliation card and a vehicle log book if issued

12. Tests

There will be a minimum of 8 tests.

13. Classes

Classes shall be in accordance with the Khanacross Regulations.

Hand held stopwatches will be used. Timing shall start at the competitors own time when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated start line and cease when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated finish line.

Penalties shall be awarded in accordance with the Khanacross Regulations.

16. Point scoring

Competitors shall be ranked by outright time

17. Protests/ Appeals

Protests or appeals must be made in accordance with Part XII or Part XIII of the National Competition Rules.

18. Judges of Fact

All officials and timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with NCR 181 and the Khanacross Regulations.
